# Gerrards Cross Golf Club – Men's Open, Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> August

## Terms and Conditions of Entry

1. Open to Gentlemen aged 18 years and over before 26<sup>th</sup> August 2010 and of Amateur status.
2. The maximum handicap will be 18. Entries will be balloted in strict handicap order if a field of 69 is entries exceeded.
3. Competitors will be made temporary members of the Club for the day.
4. The closing date for the entries is **Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2010** and no refunds will be made for any withdrawals after this time.
5. The competition committee reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry without giving a reason and to replace players who scratch after the draw has been published.
6. The format is a qualifying 18 hole individual medal off full handicap. Scores will be returned to home clubs.
7. The event will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Ltd and the Local Rules as applied by the Competition Committee whose decision shall be final.
8. Competitors shall walk at all times during a stipulated round unless granted permission to ride by the Committee. Play will be in threeballs to commence at 9.00am from the 1<sup>st</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Tees and the draw will be made in reverse handicap order.
9. Competitors shall abide by the Club's Dress rules, a copy of which will be attached to the confirmation letter sent to the competitors after the draw had been made.
10. Competitors must sign in at the desk in the Lounge 30 minutes before their starting time and should return their cards to the same desk as soon as possible after completing their rounds and before changing.
11. Competitors must report to the starter at their designated tee 5 minutes before their starting time. Please allow extra time to drive to the 11<sup>th</sup> tee car-park. Any competitor arriving up to 5 minutes after his starting time will be subject to a two shot penalty. If a competitor arrives after five minutes he shall be disqualified.
12. **Safety on the Course** – A suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signaled by the firing of a rocket. **Play shall be discontinued immediately** and shall not be resumed until a second rocket is fired.
13. **The GX Trophy, will be awarded to the best nett score together with the 1<sup>st</sup> prize voucher.** The GX Trophy will be retained by the club; the winner will receive a replica. There will also be prizes for the best scratch score and 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> nett in each handicap category.
14. No player may win more than one prize and ties will be decided on the last 9,6,3 and final holes from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee.
15. One practice round per competitor may be taken at the member's guest rate of £25.00 per round. Please telephone the office to arrange a mutually convenient time.
16. Mobile telephones may only be used in the car park. They may be carried on the course for emergency use provided they are switched off.
17. The ball the competitor plays must be listed on the Current list of Conforming Balls issued by R&A Rules Ltd. **Penalty for breach of condition – disqualification.**
18. The driver the competitor plays must have a club head named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by R&A Rules Ltd. **Penalty for breach of condition – disqualification.**

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
